Following extensive discussions with Mr Stamp and a review of the relevant documentation that he has provided, we have formed the view that Mr Stamp has not evinced anything that we would characterise as dishonest and we believe him to have been unfairly maligned.
4. Doubtless Mr Stamp will provide as much detail as is needed regarding the issues in the event that any due diligence is undertaken by a potential investor. We would be happy to assist in that process.
5. In summary, we have every reason to believe that Mr Stamp is a person of honesty and integrity and someone who would take his contractual commitments very seriously.
